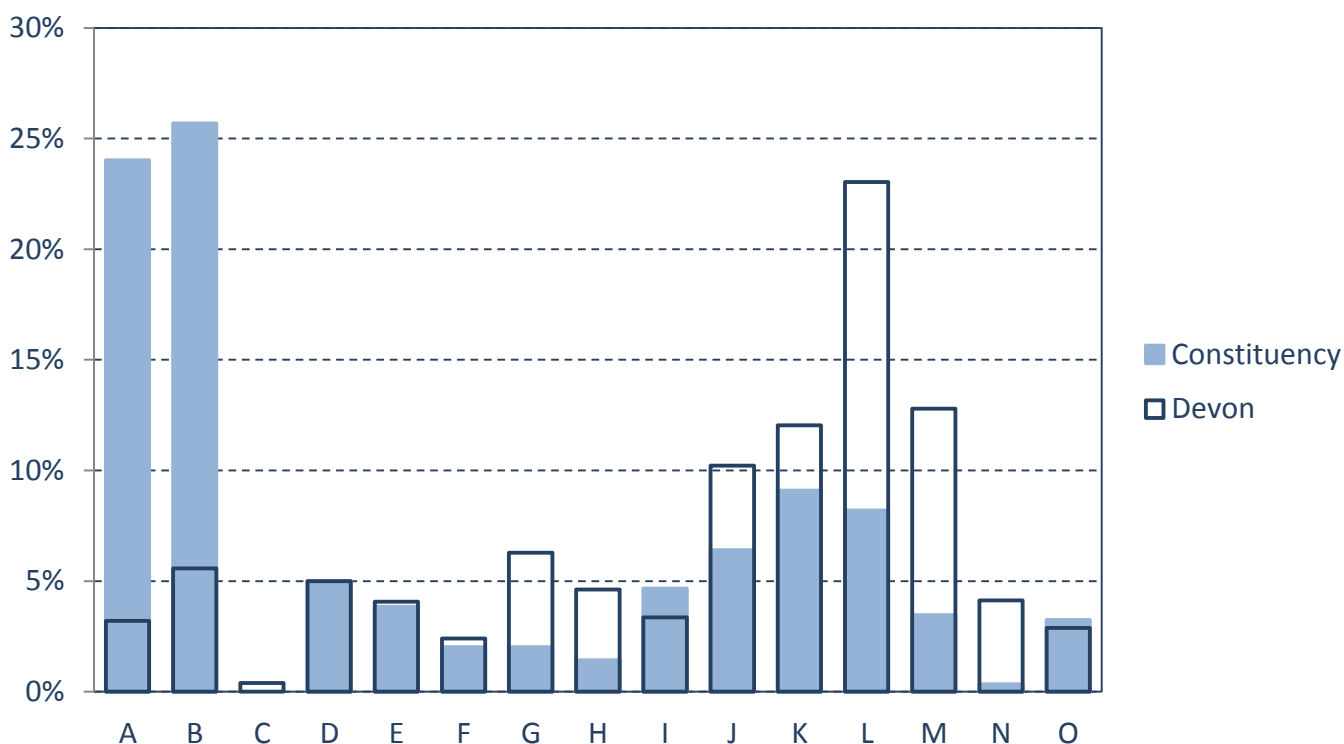


## Household type

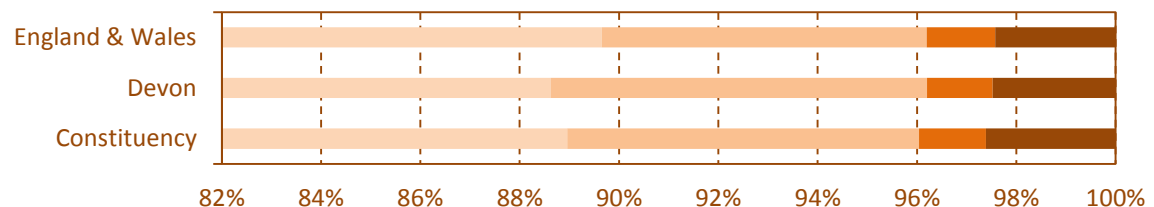

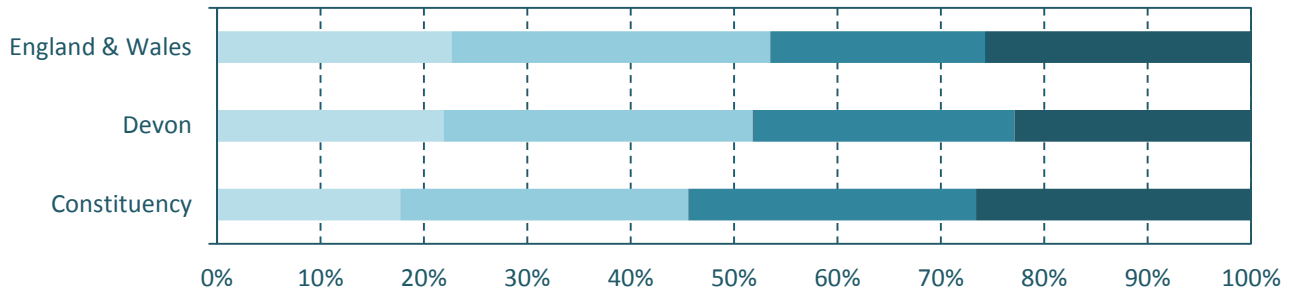

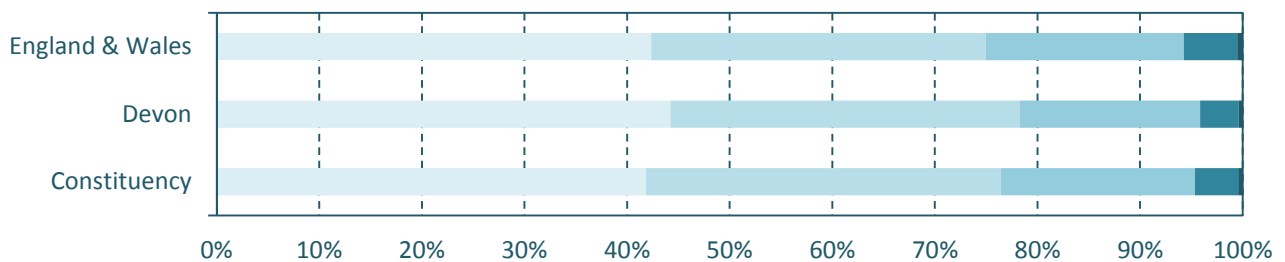

### Deprivation

Households are classed as being deprived if they fulfil one (or more) of the following criteria:

- Employment (any member of a household who is not a full-time student, and is either unemployed or long-term sick)
- Education (no person in the household has at least level 2 education, and no person aged 16-18 is a full-time student)
- Health and disability (any person in the household has general health 'bad or very bad' or has a long term health problem), and
- Housing (Household's accommodation is ether overcrowded, with an occupancy rating -1 or less, or is in a shared dwelling, or has no central heating).

### Indices of Deprivation

The Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) are the main source of data relating to deprivation in England. Each area is given a score for each of the seven domains, which are then combined to provide an overall estimate of deprivation. An IMD score has been calculated for each of these areas (and two sub areas) for your constituency, marked with an X on the graphs below. The scores for the other constituencies are shown by the light blue diamond shapes.

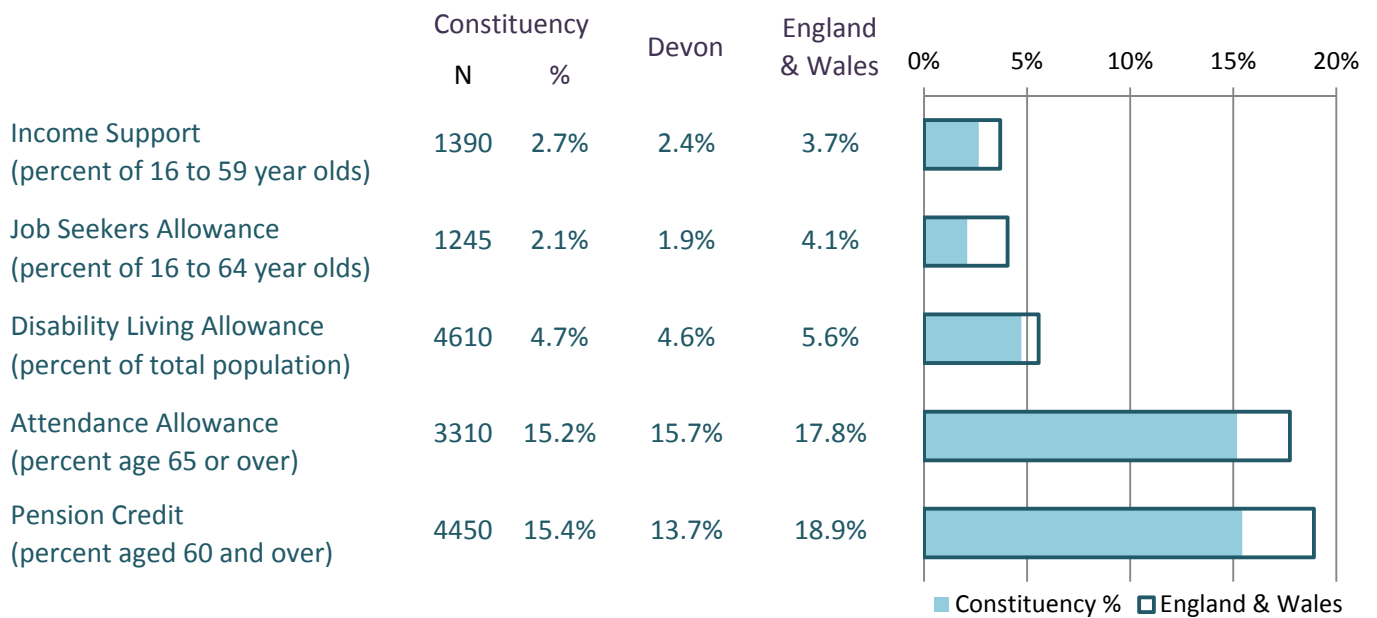
For all areas a higher score indicates greater deprivation



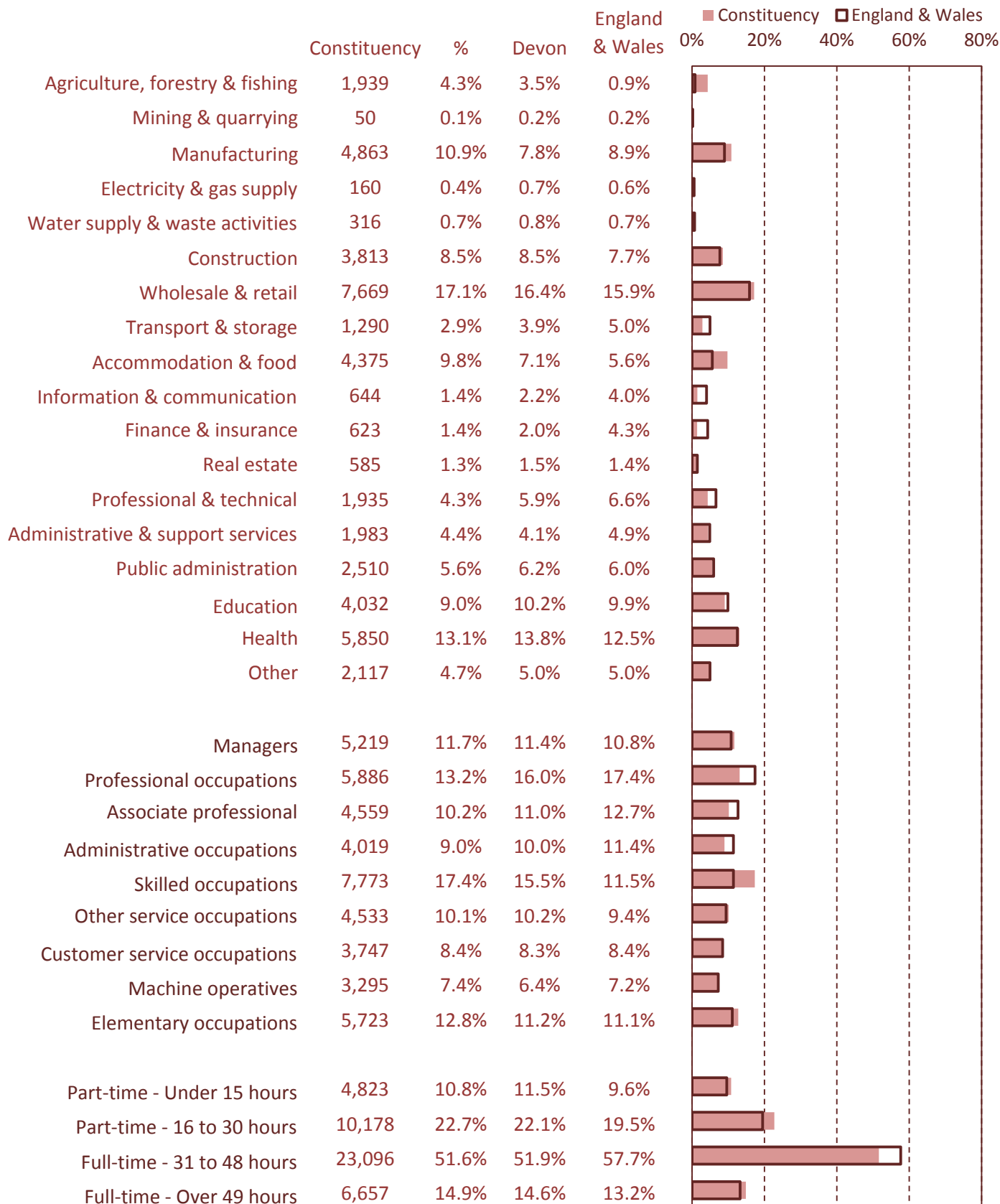

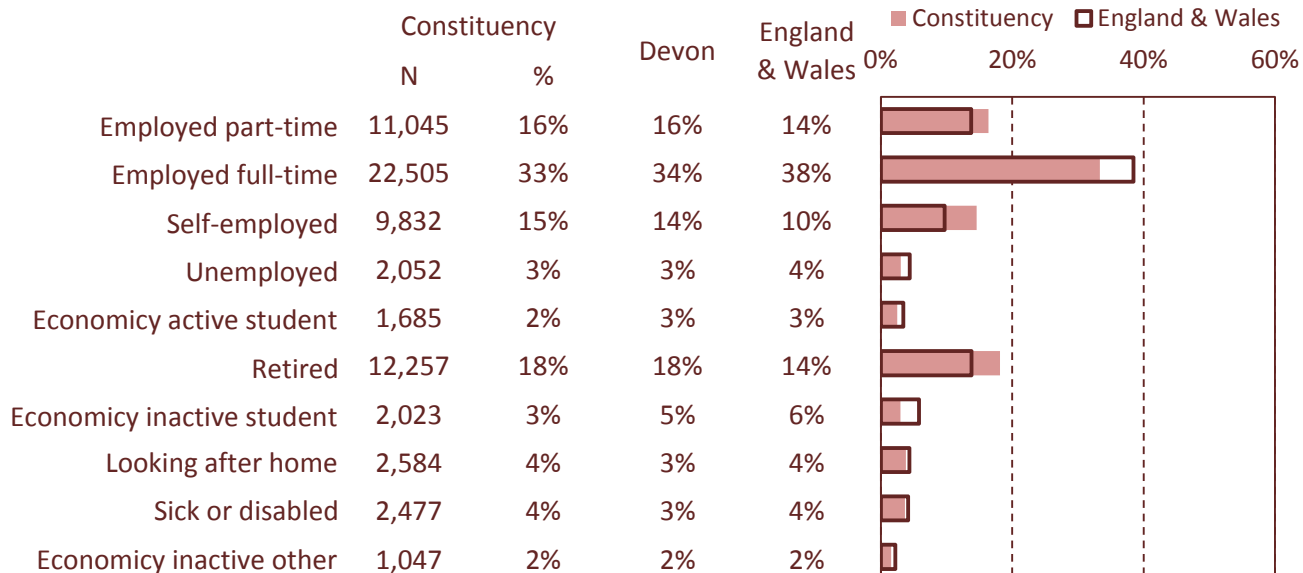

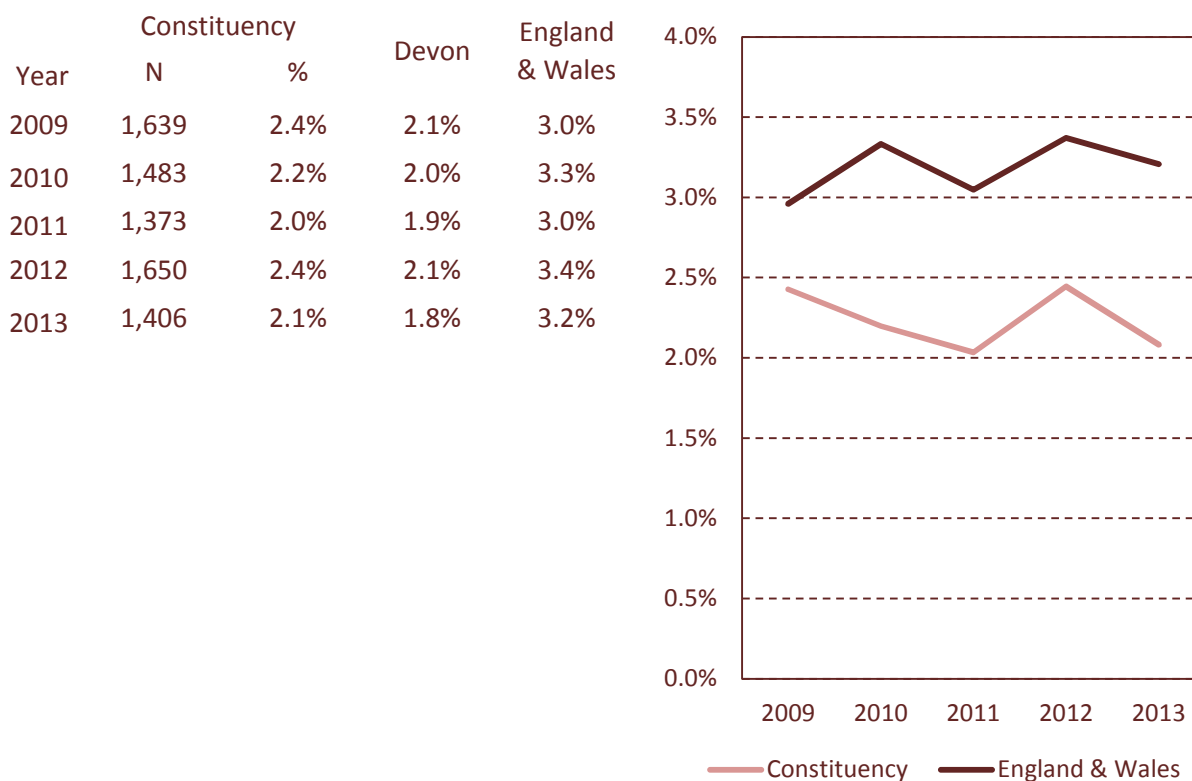

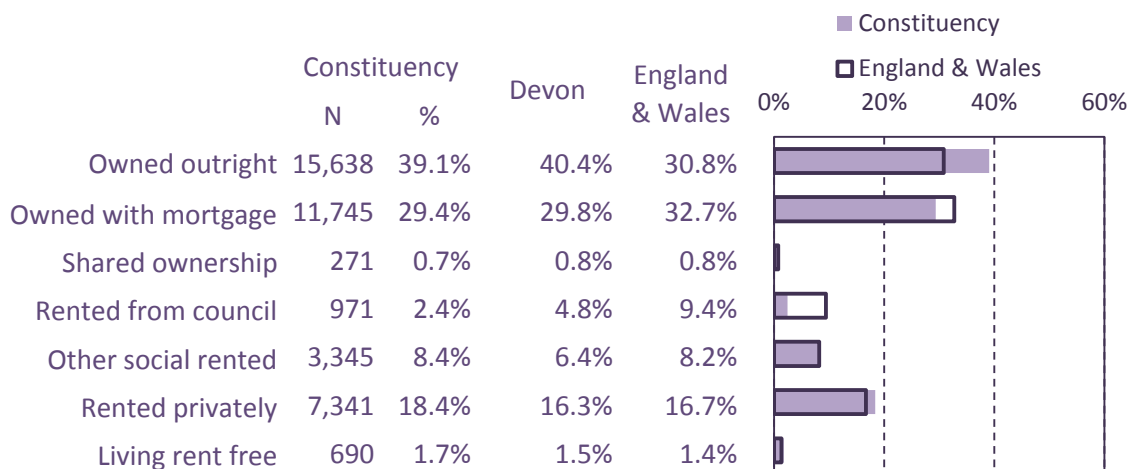

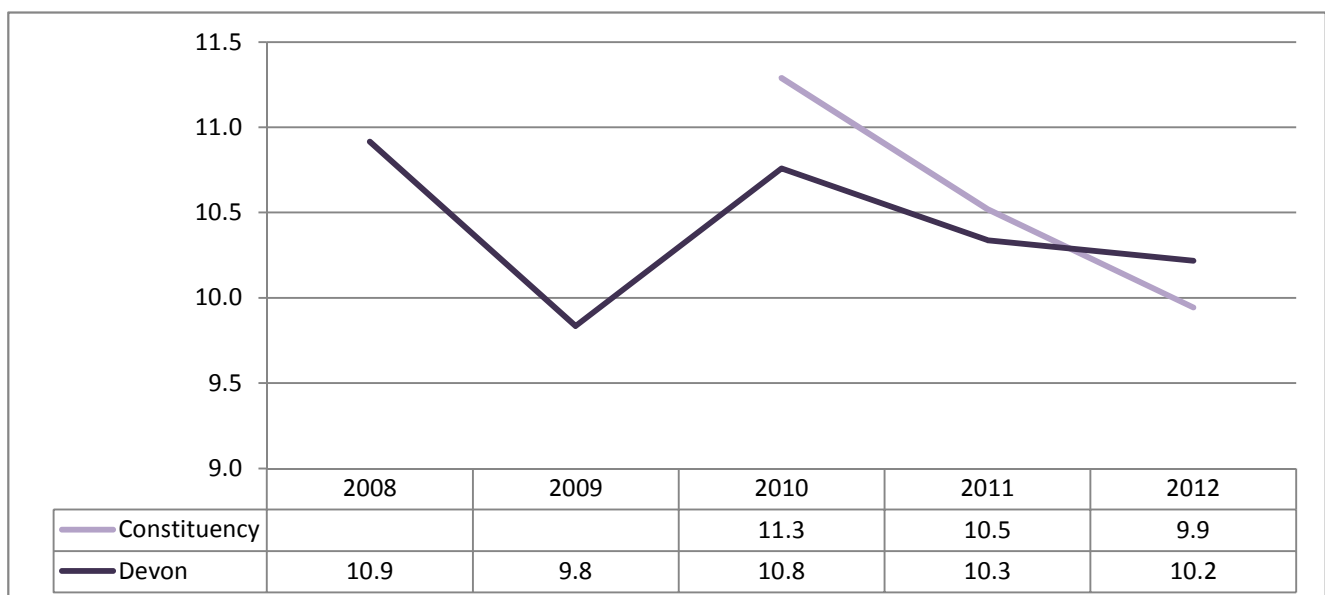

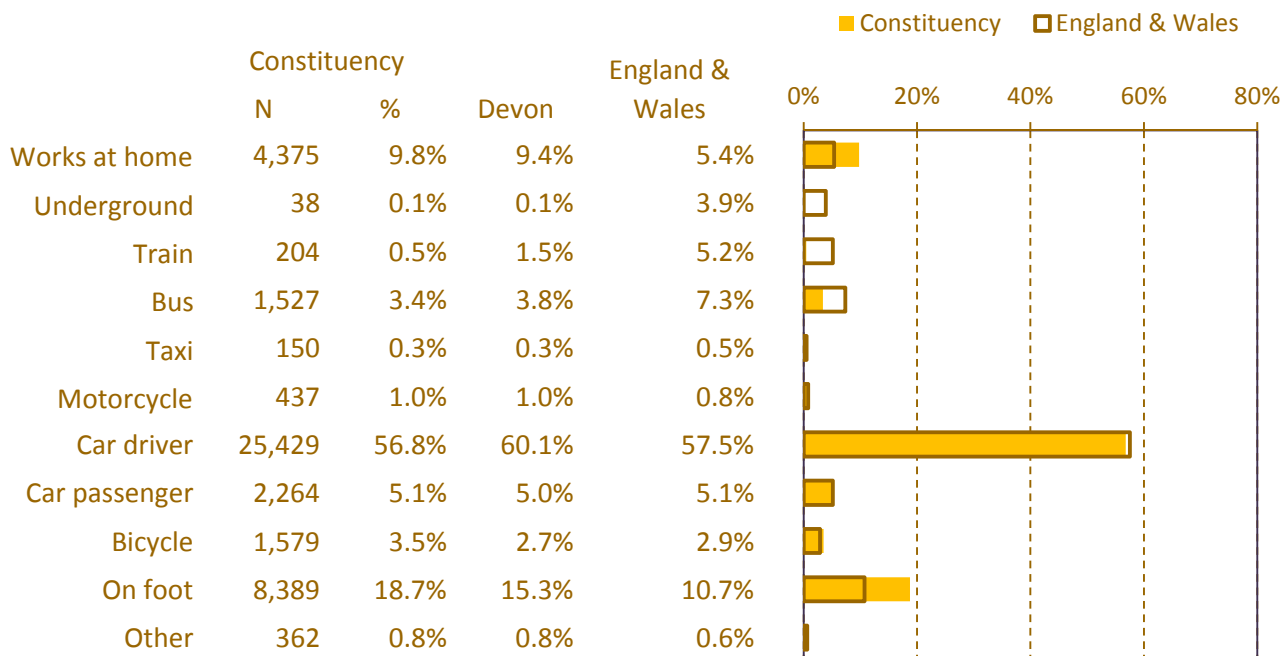
### Average house price / Earnings Ratio



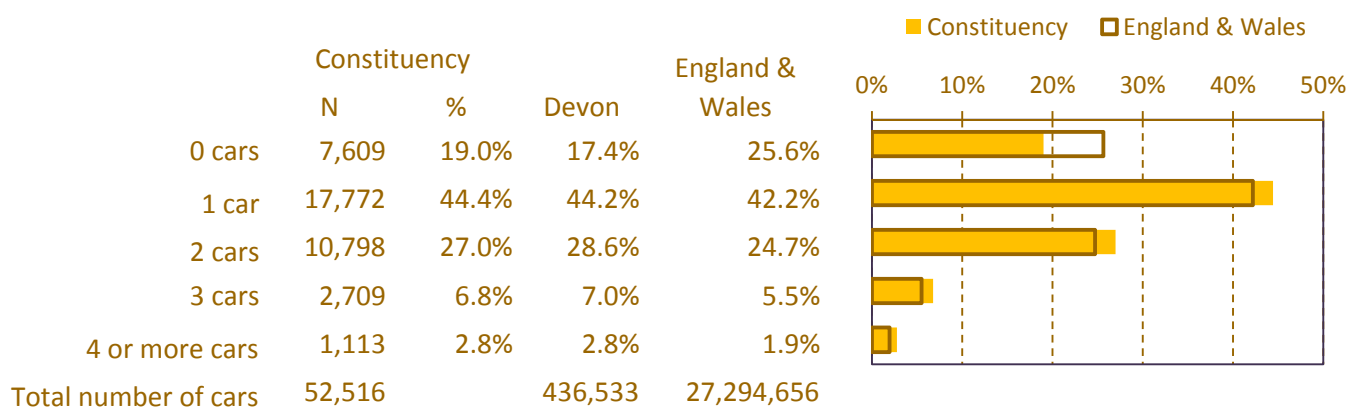
